Catechists teach the age-appropriate lessons to children and youth. The lesson plans are provided. Catechists are required to comply with diocesan screening standards.

Catechist aides help catechists with learning activities and supervision. Aides are also required to comply with diocesan screening standards.

Hospitality coordinators invite participants to bring refreshments. On the day of the session, they make beverages and arrange snacks on the serving tables.

Snack providers bring food or beverages for the fellowship that takes place at the beginning of the session.

Decorators decorate the tables and other areas where participants gather.

Greeters welcome participants at the doors.

Registrars help participants find their Home Kits. They also register newcomers and collect pay-as-you-go fees. If participants go directly to the church, registrars deliver the Home Kit to them.

Prayer leaders proclaim the scriptures or lead parts of the opening or closing prayer.

Set-up/Clean up teams set up chairs and tables if needed. They clear the fellowship area during the all-ages experience in preparation for the age-appropriate session. At the end of the session, they put the church in order.

Publishers design and post flyers in church and school. They take photos, contact the media and other parishes to announce events, or update the parish website. They design powerpoint presentations and provide technology know-how.

Office support persons make telephone calls, assemble Home Kits and keep records.
